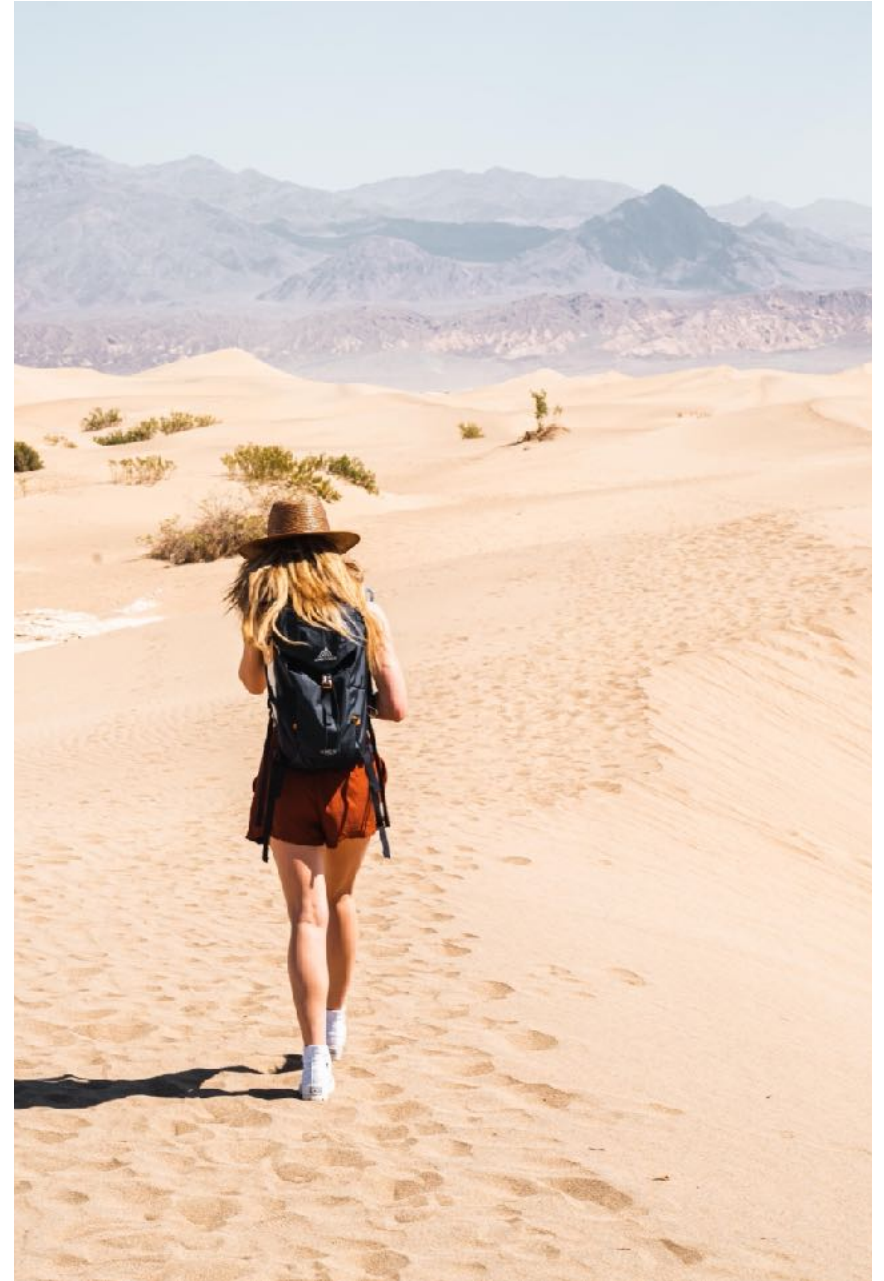

Glossary

bake in the sun – „piec się” na słońcu (pot. smażyć się)
blazing – palący, żarący
blazing (sun) – palące słońce
blizzard – zamieć śnieżna
boiling – upalny, strasznie gorący (pot. „parzący”)
cool down – ochłodzić się
dehydrated – odwodniony
extreme heat – ekstremalne upały
fan – wentylator
frosty – mroźny, oszroniony
hailstones – grad
heatwave – fala upałów
hot – gorący
humid – wilgotny (powietrze)
icy – lodowaty, oblodzony
melt – „topić się” (pot. z gorąca)
muggy – duszny i wilgotny
overcast – pochmurny (całkowite zachmurzenie)
overheated – przegrzany
record-breaking temperatures – rekordowe temperatury
scorching – skwarny, piekielnie gorący
seek shade – szukać cienia
shade – cień
shiver – drżeć z zimna
slippery – śliski
snowdrift – zaspą śnieżną
stay hydrated – utrzymywać odpowiednie nawodnienie
stifling – duszny, ciężki (powietrze)

sticky – lepki (od potu)
sunburn – oparzenie słoneczne
sunscreen – krem przeciwsłoneczny
sunny – słoneczny
sunshine – światło słoneczne, słońce
sweat – pocić się
sweltering – duszny, upalny
warm – ciepły
